

- Union Health Service offers a complete range of eye care services including comprehensive eye exams, vision testing for glasses and contacts. It is recommended that all adults be tested for eye disease every 1 to 2 years. If you have risk factors, such as diabetes, high blood pressure, heart disease, or a family history of glaucoma: are over the age of 60 or are African American, talk to your doctor about having a vision screening.
- UHS Ophthalmology services check many different functions of the eye. These tests measure your ability to see details at near and far distances, check for gaps or defects in your field of vision, and evaluate your ability to see different colors.
